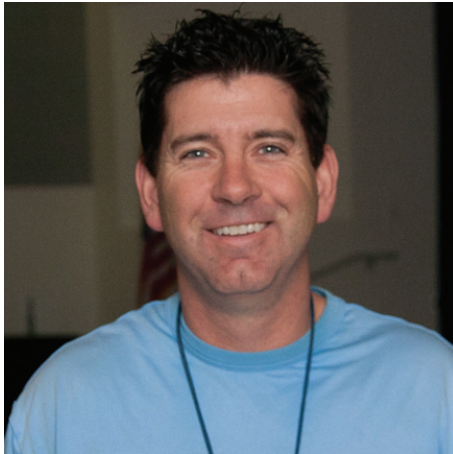


Meet Physical Education Teacher Mike Davis
